Patti Bland, M.A., CCDC, currently directs the Train the Trainer Project for the Alaska Network on Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault in Juneau, Alaska. Ms. Bland served as both advocate and lead chemical dependency counselor for New Beginnings, a shelter and community-based program in Seattle, Washington for over 12 years.

Ms. Bland has published several articles on chemical dependency and domestic violence and completed the development of domestic violence curricula for the Washington State Medical Association and the Perinatal Partnership Against Domestic Violence. Recently Ms. Bland coauthored, with Debbie Edmund, "Getting Safe and Sober: Real Tools You Can Use," an advocacy teaching kit for working with women coping with substance abuse and interpersonal violence.

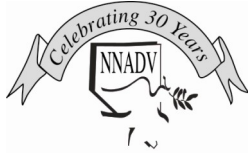
